Development of the Banks Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan (BPP) is currently underway and we need your input and feedback. The BPP will identify key projects, policies, programs, and studies aimed at developing

a convenient and safe non-automobile transportation system for local trips within the city and connections to regional trail systems. Over the past several months, the project team and a stakeholder advisory committee (SAC) have worked to develop a vision and evaluation metrics for the plan, review existing conditions for bicyclists and pedestrians in the city, and identify desired elements of the plan.

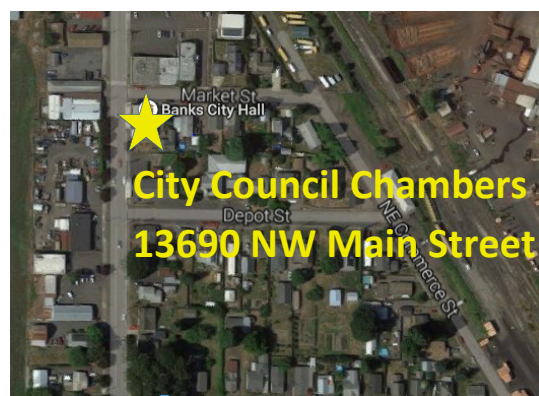
